COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

OBJECTIVE

The objective of the *Turkish Education Association Happy Day Board Design Competition* is to renovate the current design of the *Happy Day Board*, which is sent by the Turkish Education Association in return for donations made on happy days, e.g. weddings, openings, etc.

CONDITIONS

Participants are required to be an undergraduate/graduate student registered at TED University Faculty of Architecture and Design in the Spring Semester of the Academic Year 2021/22.

Students can participate in the competition as individuals or as a team; in any case, each student can participate with only one entry, whether it is individual or team. Teams can consist of up to three people.

FORMAT

The following files must be submitted via e-mail by the given date to participate in the competition:

- 1. **Design sheet**: The project design must be presented on a single A2 sheet (59.4 x 42 cm) and the file must be in *jpeg* format with 300 dpi resolution, and must contain:
 - A. <u>Project visuals</u>: Visuals can be prepared based on a hand-drawn, rendered or a model photo. Material specifications must also be included.
 - B. <u>Scaled technical drawings</u>: These must be prepared in a way that all the details of the product are clearly displayed.
 - C. <u>Nickname</u>: The design sheet must be completely anonymous and must not contain any identifying information. The applicant must choose a nickname consisting of three letters and three numbers (e.g. AAA-000) and print it at the top right corner of the sheet.
- 2. **Design report:** A design report of maximum 300 words, describing the story of the design, material and production details, must be presented on a single A4 sheet. The nickname chosen by the applicant must be printed at the top right corner of the page.
- **3. Application form**: The attached application form must be filled out and signed. Team applications must be signed by all team members.

Applications must be submitted to tasarimyarismasi@tedu.edu.tr via Wetransfer download link (www.wetransfer.com) until 13.05.2022 at 23:59. Applications that do not comply with the specified participation format will not be processed.

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Entries will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Aesthetics
- Originality
- Manufacturability
- Cost
- Usability
- Suitability for purpose

AWARDS

• First place: TRY 10.00

• Second place: TRY 5,000

• Third place: TRY 2.500

COPYRIGHTS

All copyright, publication, usage and exhibition rights of those entries received an award and entitled to be exhibited in the competition are to be reserved exclusively by the Turkish Education Association. These entries will be exhibited with the artist's credits in the exhibition to be held at the end of the competition.

The participant accepts to give permission/consent to the Turkish Education Association for the use of reproduction, processing, representation, public broadcasting and publishing rights of their entries which are entitled to receive an award in accordance with the Law on Intellectual and Artistic Works and other relevant legislation.

For the entries used in this way, the owner of the entry accepts, declares and undertakes that they will not withdraw the given permission later and will not prevent the use of their work in the above-mentioned way, or that they will not make any claims or demands in terms of copyright or financial rights. The owner of the entry also accepts in advance that the Turkish Education Association will not have any responsibility for the use of their works by third parties inconsistently with this article.

The awarded or the purchased entries can be used by the Turkish Education Association aligned with the purpose of the competition. The Turkish Education Association does not make any additional payments to the authors for the printed and visual publication or for the exhibition of these entries.

The awarded entries in the competition can be published on the websites www.tedu.edu.tr and www.ted.org.tr.

In addition, the Turkish Education Association can choose and purchase the designs and prototype products that it deems appropriate for a price equal to the honorable mention. In this case, all provisions applicable to the awarded products also apply to the purchased product.

By submitting their entries to this competition, the participants are considered to have accepted all the above-mentioned conditions.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Happy day boards are an effort to raise funds for the TED scholarship fund and to strengthen the perception of the non-governmental organization by increasing the visibility of the Turkish Education Association.

Happy day boards are to be transferred to the venue of the specific event (hotel, school, etc.) and installed by Turkish Education Association mobile teams in Ankara, Istanbul and Izmir; and they are to be disassembled and taken back at the end of the event.

The names of the people who ordered the happy day board are to be displayed on a strip of paper attached to the board. Multiple names can be printed on the same board.

The panel should be designed in such a way that it can be transported by a vehicle and easily installed by a single person.
